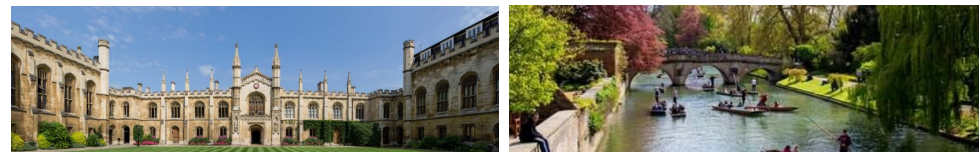

### PLEASE NOTE:

- ◆ **Class size:** maximum of 12. Levels Available: Beginner to Advanced.
- ◆ **Accommodation:**
  - All **homestays** are close to the school, most within walking distance. They will provide breakfast and dinner every day, and lunch during the weekend (if you are on a weekend excursion they will give you a packed lunch). During the week you can have lunch at the school cafeteria. The homestay will provide you with a laundry service once a week.
  - **Residential** accommodation in shared dormitories. All the meals will be in the school, if you go out on a full-day excursion, the school will give you a packed lunch. Teenagers are supervised 24 hours a day and they are not allowed out of the school grounds unaccompanied.
