Location

Edinburgh is a perfect destination for junior students of all ages!

- The school is close to some of the best visitor attractions in Edinburgh, including the *Scottish National Gallery*, *Edinburgh Castle* and the *historic Old Town*.
- 15 minutes' walk to Princes Street, one of the main shopping areas of the city.
- 15 minutes' walk to Edinburgh Haymarket Train Station and 10 minutes by tram to Edinburgh Waverley Train Station.
- The school will deliver a course focusing on Scottish history, culture and international communication.

Location

- Originating as the School of Arts of Edinburgh in 1821, Heriot-Watt is now a modern University spread over four campuses. Our programme is based on the main Edinburgh campus, in Riccarton on the edge of Edinburgh.
- The campus is about 30 mins by public transport to the city centre.

- ◆ Trinity Exams (GESE) will be charged at £90.00 per student. This includes materials, exam and two preparation sessions. Student over 16 years old.

- ◆ Computer Access: Wi-Fi access available in accommodation only. Computer room is available on campus.
- ◆ Accommodation: all accommodation is single rooms en-suite. Maximum sharing one bedroom: 1. Ratio of rooms/shower: 1. Towels are NOT provided.
- ◆ Student Profile: Recommended ages: 12—17. Number of students at peak: 450. Nationality Mix: Chinese, Italian, Russian and Greek.
- ◆ Facilities:
 - Laundry: A laundrette is situated on-site. It is open 24/7 and charges £2.20 for a wash and £1.20 for a dry. Bed linen will be washed once a week by the University.
 - Social spaces: Each flat has a kitchen/ living space for the students to relax in.
- ◆ Meals:
 - Breakfast: Continental breakfast i.e. cereal, toast, fruit, juices, tea & coffee.
 - Lunch: 2 hot main choices (one of which is vegetarian) pasta, salad bar and dessert.
 - Dinner: 2 hot main courses (one of which is vegetarian), pasta, salad bar and dessert.
- ◆ Sports Facilities: The campus has excellent sports facilities which are scheduled into the programme. There is a gym available on site for the group leaders.
- ◆ Group Leader Information: Security: There is a 24hr security team that work to keep the campus secure. Each bedroom has a key and lost keys are charged at £25.
Shop/Café: There is a shop and café based on site and is open Monday - Friday all day and the mornings at the weekends.
