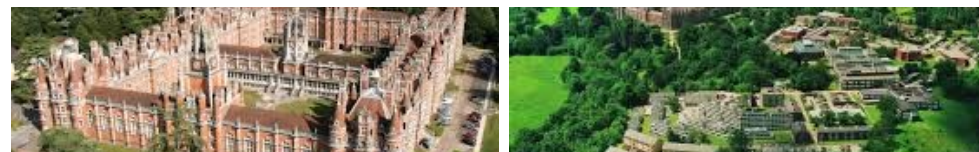

Location

- With the striking Founder's Building visible across the campus, Royal Holloway is situated 30 km from central London. It is now one of the leading universities in the country and has developed some of the best sports facilities of any university institution in the London area boasting a new sports hall, tennis courts and expansive sports fields.
- Time to central London: 40mins by public transport.

Services included:

- ◆ Full board, campus accommodation in single en-suite rooms arranged in flats of 6-8.

PLEASE NOTE:

- ◆ Prices based on group size of 15 students. There will be a supplementary charge for smaller groups.
- ◆ Average students per class: 16. Levels Available: Elementary to Proficiency (programme can be adjusted to lower English levels).
- ◆ Price for additional Group Leaders to be confirmed.
- ◆ Trinity Exams (GESE) will be charged at £90.00 per student. This includes materials, exam and two preparation sessions.
- ◆ The sample programme above is subject to changes.
- ◆ All Group Leaders will need to provide a Police 'certificate of good conduct' or 'certificate of criminal record' from their country of residence.
- ◆ Computer Access: Wi-Fi is available across campus. Computer rooms: group leaders have unlimited access to the computer room throughout the day.
- ◆ Accommodation: single en-suite bedrooms arranged in flats of 6-8. Maximum sharing one bedroom: 1. Ratio of rooms/shower: 1. Towels are not provided.
- ◆ Student Profile: Recommended ages: 10-17. Number of students at peak: 1000. Nationality Mix: Chinese, Russian, Turkish, Japanese and Italian.
- ◆ Facilities:
 - Laundry: a launderette is situated in The Hub Reception. It is open till late at night and charges £3.00 for a wash and £2.00 for a dry. Washing powder must be purchased.
 - Social spaces: Each flat has a kitchen/ living space for the students to relax in.
- ◆ Meals:
 - Breakfast: Continental breakfast i.e. cereal, toast, fruit, juices, tea & coffee. Cooked breakfast every Sunday.
 - Lunch: 2 hot main choices (one of which is vegetarian) with potato of the day, salad bar and dessert.
 - Dinner: 2 hot main courses (one of which is vegetarian), salad bar and dessert.
- ◆ Sports Facilities: Sports take place in the fantastic sports centre with outdoor fields, tennis court, basketball courts and football pitches. The group leaders can also use the multi-gym situated on site for a small charge.
- ◆ Group Leader Information:
 - Security: There is a 24hr security team that work to keep the campus secure.
 - Shop/Café: 'The Store' is the campus shop, a mini supermarket selling snacks, beverages, campus souvenirs and toiletries. It is open daily. There are three cafes on site.
