Location

PLEASE NOTE:

• Class size: maximum of 14 in high season, 12 in low season. Levels Available: Beginner to Proficiency (A1-C2). All lessons are 45 minutes. Books are charged separately and there is the option of e-books. ID cards are processed on the first day and cost €5.00, they give access to the school facilities, discounts in Ozone café, on excursions, in shops and restaurants.

HOMESTAY Accommodation:

The host families are friendly, welcoming and hospitable, close to the school and carefully selected. They offer breakfast and dinner every day, and full board at weekends. The accommodation is in single room (year round) or shared room (summer only). Distance from accommodation to school is between 5 minutes' walk to 30 minutes by bus depending on traffic.

♦ RESIDENCE Accommodation:

They are bright, modern, fully equipped apartments or houses. All situated within 5 to 20 minutes' walk from the school. Self-catering. They offer en-suite single or shared room options with free internet access.
