Location

- ◆ Located on the large modern city campus of Queen Mary University of London.

- ◆ **Language Programme:**
 - Taught by qualified English teachers
 - 20 x 45 minute lessons per week morning or afternoon
 - Placement test on day 1 to ensure students in appropriate level
 - Maximum 15 students per class
 - Spacious classrooms with projectors and teacher internet access to use online resources
 - Curriculum with emphasis on communication skills
 - Materials included
 - Trinity exam preparation available.
- ◆ **Accommodation Facilities:**
 - Laundry available in residence building
 - Towels not available
 - Communal space in each flat
 - Room furniture includes a mini-fridge, wardrobe, desk and chair
 - Rooms cleaned weekly
