- ◆ Average students per class: 16. Levels Available: Elementary to Proficiency.
- ◆ Price for additional Group Leaders to be confirmed.
- ◆ Trinity Exams (GESE) will be charged at £90.00 per student. This includes materials, exam and two preparation sessions. Student over 16 years old.
- ◆ The sample programme above is subject to changes.
- ◆ All Group Leaders will need to provide a Police 'certificate of good conduct' or 'certificate of criminal record' from their country of residence.
- ◆ Computer Access: there is Wi-Fi on site and is available in communal areas and the en-suite accommodation. Computer rooms: A computer room is available for the students use.
- ◆ Accommodation: Single en-suite bedrooms arranged along corridors of 6-8 rooms. Maximum sharing one bedroom: 1. Ratio of rooms/shower: private bathrooms. Towels NOT provided.
- ◆ Student Profile: Student ages: 12 -17. Number of students at peak: 300. Nationality Mix: Italian, Russian, Spanish and Turkish.
- ◆ Facilities:
  - Laundry: Coin operated machines cost £2.00 for a wash and £1.00 for a dry. Bed linen will be changed once a week by the university laundry.
  - Social spaces: Each accommodation block has a communal kitchen which can be used as a social space.
- ◆ Meals:
  - Breakfast: Continental buffet breakfast
  - Lunch: Typically two hot options (one vegetarian), along with side dishes such as salad, pasta, rice etc. and a dessert and drink.
  - Dinner: Same choices as lunch.
- ◆ Sports Facilities: The Harcourt Hill Campus has its own sports centre which includes a sports hall, gym and swimming pool.
- ◆ Group Leader Information:
  - Security: There is a 24hr security team that work to keep the campus secure. There are no safes in the bed-rooms. In en-suite accommodation a swipe card is used. £10.00 charge for a lost card.
  - Shop/Café: There is no shop on-site but the centre of Oxford is a short bus ride away.
