- Computer Access: Wi-Fi access is provided across campus for students and group leaders. Computer access is available on campus.
- Accommodation: all accommodation is single and twin en-suite rooms arranged in flats of 6-8. Maximum sharing one bedroom: 2. Ratio of rooms/shower: 1:2. Towels are not provided.
- Student Profile: Recommended ages: 8—17. Number of students at peak: 400. Nationality Mix: Chinese, Italian, Russian, Turkish and Spanish.
- ♦ Facilities:
 - Laundry: A laundrette is situated nest to the Dean building and is available at times to suit. It costs $\pounds 2.00$ for a wash and $\pounds 1.00$ for a dry.
