Barnard College of Columbia University is a liberalarts college that was founded in 1889 as a response to Columbia's refusal to adwomen into the institution. It is one of the oldestwomen's colleges in the world and one of the most selective in the US.

The campus is located in the Upper West neighborhood of Manhatstretching along Broadway between 116th and 120th Streets. Barnard is located directly acrossfrom Columbia University's main campus. Barnard College, Columbia University is conveniently located near 1 train (116 Street Station - Columbia University) as well as A, B, C and D trains (125 Street). TimesSquare is just a 15 -minute short ride away.





Services included:

- 20 lessons (45 minutes each) of English Classes per week with qualified teachers.
- All course materials and an end-of-course certificate.
- Full board on weekdays and brunch & dinner on weekends:

All breakfast and lunch in the cafeteria on campus (weekdays). The dining hall offers hot and cold options, including pizza, comfort food, made-to-order grill and deli, salads, etc. Brunch on weekends. Daily dinners in local cafés and restaurants or on campus.

Plimpton Hall is situated at the corner of 121st Street, at a short walking distance from the campus main building. It is a suite-style residence hall. There are 4 single rooms and 1 double room in each suite accommodating a total of 6 people per suite. Each suite has its own bathroom (1:6 ratio) and a kitchen with a sink, stove/oven, and refrigerator. Each room has an extra long twin bed, desk, chair, dresser, and wardrobe or closet space.

*Note: Male and femaleparticipants/group leaders are separated by floors and not housed together in the same room/apartment.

- Mini-stay cleanings of bedrooms/bathrooms during the stay.
- Arrival and Departure Transfer.
- Excursions & Campus Activities program as per schedule below. It includes mass transportation costs.
- Medical Travel Insurance.
